

Library Progressive Report

A library is a mirror to any institution in this world. It depicts the effort that has been put into it. Library is a soul of any institution. Our institution was established in 2014 and since then it has been on the path of growth and success. Similar to which the library of the college which started with 116 books is now above to an approx. of 5000 books, including both UG and PG supplements.

Amid the pandemic, we also organized a General Quiz open to both students as well faculties in 2020. Certificates were provided for the encouraging participations. In 2021, Hans foundation donated around 2800 books and 30 Almirah for the betterment of students and college library also. In the year 2021 pushing forward the way, we also registered our college on NDLI Platform (National Digital Library of India), a central government initiative, as a NDLI College Club of 120 members, which is giving access to word wide resources and networks. For the betterment of students, the NDLI College Club further organized 2 online webinar to educating the message about it.

The proposed concepts of e-Granthalaya by the department of Higher Education, Uttarakhand and Govt. of Uttarakhand was implemented in 2020 to convert traditional library into e- library. All the classified and catalogued books data have been uploaded on it and all college faculty members and non-teaching staff also registered into the software. It provides the issue- return, internet resources, bound title, Web OPAC and mobile app service to the users. We have proposed several ideas to multiple organizations for the development of our College Library. In our college Library we also provide the newspaper clipping photocopying services.

We have also indicated the process of registering our college library on INFLIBNET powered N-List, which is provide various e- resources to its users. It is useful for UG, PG and researchers also. We will always go-ahead, which is necessary for betterment of college and students also.
